ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER RE: Statutory Good and Gain Time

I, R. James Stroker, pursuant to authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida, do hereby order that all persons incarcerated for criminal contempt of court are entitled to credit for statutory good and gain time to accrue in the same manner as any other inmate incarcerated on a criminal sentence. Persons held for civil contempt are not entitled to statutory good time or gain time.
