ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER GOVERNING FAMILY COURT SERVICES FORMS

WHEREAS, Florida Family Law Rule of Procedure 12.750 (b) (5) effective January 1, 1999 defines “approved forms” that are provided by family self-help programs as either forms approved by the Florida Supreme Court or forms approved in writing by the Chief Judge of a circuit that are not inconsistent with the Supreme Court approved forms; and

WHEREAS, Family Court Services in this Circuit currently provides both the Supreme Court approved forms and additional forms that are not inconsistent with the Supreme Court forms; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Chief Judge of this Circuit approve by Administrative Order these additional forms provided by Family Court Services;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Belvin Perry, Jr. pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit under rule 2.050 hereby approve all forms currently provided by Family Court Services to pro se litigants in family law matters that are in addition to the Supreme Court forms provided by Family Court Services.
