## FINAL ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Wren seeks certiorari review of a decision of a hearing officer affirming the suspension of her driver's license. We waive oral argument pursuant to Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.320. We have carefully considered Wren's petition, the Department's response, Wren's reply, both appendices, and have read the transcript of the hearing.

With regard to the three points Wren raises in her petition, we find and conclude that there was substantial competent evidence to support the hearing officer's determinations that (1) there was sufficient probable cause to stop Wren for the traffic offense of Failing to Yield to an

Emergency Vehicle; (2) she was not unreasonably or unlawfully detained after the stop, and (3) there was sufficient probable cause to lawfully arrest her for the offense of Driving While Under the Influence.
