FINAL ORDER DENYING AMENDED PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Baer seeks review of an order of a hearing officer after a formal review hearing sustaining the suspension of his driver's license. We dispense with oral argument pursuant to Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.320. After careful review, we reject Petitioner's three arguments. We conclude that there was sufficient competent evidence to support the hearing officer's findings that the officer had probable cause to lawfully arrest petitioner for DUI based upon his observations of Petitioner's erratic driving and signs of impairment, and that Petitioner refused the breath alcohol test and did not recant the refusal. Petitioner was accorded due process.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Amended Petition for

Writ of Certiorari is **DENIED**.
