

**ORDER PROVIDING REVISED PROCEDURES FOR THE CLERK OF COURT FOR
PROCESSING CHILD SUPPORT PAYMENTS IN OSCEOLA COUNTY**

WHEREAS, in an effort to provide more efficient processing and accounting of child support payments submitted to the Clerk of Court in Osceola County the following revised procedures are necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Belvin Perry, Jr., pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida under Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.050, order the following:

1. For the purpose of ensuring that the Clerk of Court administrative fees are correctly deducted from the child support payments and are correctly accounted for, the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Osceola County shall determine the weekly rate of child support and/or arrearage amounts and will implement this rate into the Clerk of Court's computer system weekly.
2. These computer system procedures shall not effect how the employer/respondent pays the child support nor shall these procedures record the payments made as only partial payments.
3. This Administrative Order is effective nunc pro tunc to January 1, 2002.
