## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER GOVERNING THE REMOVAL OF FILES FROM THE JUVENILE DIVISION OF THE CLERKS' OFFICE IN ORANGE AND OSCEOLA COUNTIES

WHEREAS, it is necessary from time to time for attorneys working in the Magistrate Department of the Court to review court files in cases involving juveniles in order to hear matters referred to them by Judges sitting in the Juvenile Divisions of the Court; and

WHEREAS, it is also necessary from time to time for the Magistrates to remove the court files from the courthouse in cases involving juveniles in order to properly review the files and research the relevant questions of law;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Belvin Perry, Jr., pursuant to the authority vested in me as

Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida and Florida Rule of Judicial Administration

2.050, hereby **ORDER** that attorneys who are employed in the Magistrate Department of the

Court shall be allowed to check out and remove from the courthouse the juvenile court files of

the cases referred to them.
