<u>ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER CREATING COUNTY COURT</u> <u>SUBDIVISION 71-H, OSCEOLA COUNTY</u>

WHEREAS, the Circuit and County Courts in Osceola County are organized into divisions for more efficient case and records management; and

WHEREAS, caseloads in each division are identified by numbered subdivisions to facilitate the exchange of caseloads when changes of division assignment occur; and

WHEREAS, the volume of cases filed in the County Court for Osceola County warrant the creation of an additional subdivision;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Belvin Perry, Jr., pursuant to the authority vested in me as

Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida under Florida Rule of Judicial

Administration 2.215, order the following, effective January 2, 2007:

Subdivision 71-H is hereby created within the County Court for Osceola County to handle county criminal, misdemeanor, and traffic cases. The Clerk of Court shall begin assigning all new county criminal, misdemeanor, and traffic cases equally and randomly among Subdivisions 70-H, 80-H, and 71-H on January 2, 2007.
