**AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER DIRECTING THE CLERK OF COURT,
ORANGE COUNTY AND OSCEOLA COUNTY, TO SEND A COPY OF ALL
NON-CRIMINAL SEALING ORDERS TO GENERAL COUNSEL
UPON ENTRY OF THE SEALING ORDER**

WHEREAS, pursuant to s. 2(d), Art. V of the Florida Constitution and section 43.26, Florida Statutes, the chief judge of each judicial circuit is charged with the authority and the power to do everything necessary to promote the prompt and efficient administration of justice; and

WHEREAS, to create and maintain an organization capable of effecting the efficient, prompt, and proper administration of justice for the citizens of this State, the Chief Judge is required to exercise direction, *see* Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.215(b)(2), (b)(3);

NOW THEREFORE, I, Belvin Perry, Jr., pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida under Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, hereby order the following, effective **immediately**:

1. The Clerk of Court for Orange County and the Clerk of Court for Osceola County shall send a copy of all non-criminal sealing orders which have been entered pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420, or per order of a judge, to General Counsel upon entry of the sealing order. This Order encompasses all non-criminal sealing orders regardless of whether the sealing order seals, closes, expunges, removes from the docket, or any variation thereof.
