**FINAL ORDER AFFIRMING TRIAL COURT**

William McKnight appeals the trial court's Order denying his Motion for New Trial, rendered December 26, 2006. This Court has jurisdiction pursuant to Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.030(c)(1).
