## AMENDED ORDER RE-ACTIVATING SUBDIVISION 50 IN THE COUNTY SPECIALIZED DIVISION AND DE-ACTIVATING SUBDIVISION 74 IN THE COUNTY CIVIL DIVISION, ORANGE COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Circuit and County Courts in Orange County are organized into divisions for more efficient case and records management; and

WHEREAS, caseloads in each division are identified by numbered subdivisions to facilitate the exchange of caseloads when changes of division assignment occur; and

**WHEREAS,** for the sake of judicial economy and to prevent confusion, occasionally subdivisions may need to be de-activated, re-activated, or new subdivisions created;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Belvin Perry, Jr., pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida under Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215 order the following, effective immediately, unless otherwise provided herein:

- 1. Effective **September 30, 2008**, Subdivision 74 in the County Civil Division in Orange County shall not be assigned any new cases and shall be de-activated upon the disposition of all cases currently assigned.
- 2. Beginning **September 30, 2008**, the Clerk shall randomly assign all County Civil cases equally between the four civil divisions (i.e. 70, 71, 72, and 73).
- 3. Subdivision 50 in the County Specialized Division is hereby re-activated and shall begin operation on **November 3, 2008**.

4. Effective **November 3, 2008**, the Honorable Jerry L. Brewer shall be assigned to Subdivision 50 in the County Specialized Division until further order.

5. Administrative Order No. 2008-12 is vacated and set aside and has been incorporated and/or amended herein.
