**NOW, THEREFORE, I,** Belvin Perry, Jr., pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida under Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215 order the following:

1. With the exception of parking matters assigned to a traffic hearing officer, **effective June 8, 2009**, the Clerk of Court in the Criminal Division in Orange County will begin assigning newly filed misdemeanor cases to "Division A" in the County Criminal Division.

Accordingly, each new case filed shall be assigned to "Division A" until arraignment, at which time each case shall be assigned to the County Criminal Division assigned to cover arraignments.

2. This Order only applies to new cases filed on or about June 8, 2009.
