**ORDER VACATING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS**  
**07-92-21-02, 2007-02-01, 2008-12-01, 2008-15, 2008-30, 2008-31, AND 2012-21**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article V, Section 2(d) of the Florida Constitution and section 43.26, Florida Statutes, the chief judge of each judicial circuit is charged with the authority and the power to do everything necessary to promote the prompt and efficient administration of justice; and

**WHEREAS**, Administrative Order No. 07-92-21-02, No. 2007-02-01, No. 2008-12-01, No. 2008-15, No. 2008-30, No. 2008-31, and No. 2012-21, having fulfilled the purpose for which each was issued and are no longer required;

Administrative Order No. 2007-02-01, entered on June 27, 2007, Re-activating Circuit Court Subdivision 08-4 and Establishing a Caseload, Orange County;

Administrative Order No. 2008-12-01, entered on September 17, 2008, Re-activating Subdivision 50 in the County Specialized Division and De-activating Subdivision 74 in the County Civil Division, Orange County;

Administrative Order No. 2008-15, entered on October 17, 2008, Vacating Administrative Order 07-96-22;

Administrative Order No. 2008-30, entered on December 31, 2008, Assigning Remaining Caseload from De-activated Subdivision 74 to Subdivision 71 in the County Civil Division, Orange County;

Administrative Order No. 2008-31, entered on December 19, 2008, Renumbering Orange County Subdivision 24 to Subdivision 27; and

Administrative Order No. 2012-21, entered on October 17, 2012, Creating Circuit Court Subdivision 12-A and Establishing a Caseload, Osceola County

are each formally vacated. Vacating an Administrative Order that vacates a prior Order does not revive the prior Order.
