THE HONORABLE RENEE A. ROCHE shall be the Acting Chief Judge from July 1, 2019, through and including July 31, 2019.

THE HONORABLE ALICE L. BLACKWELL shall be the Acting Chief Judge from August 1, 2019, through and including September 30, 2019.

THE HONORABLE JON B. MORGAN shall be the Acting Chief Judge from

October 1, 2019, through and including November 30, 2019.

THE HONORABLE ROBERT J. EGAN shall be the Acting Chief Judge from

December 1, 2019, through and including December 31, 2019.
