**ORDER VACATING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2004-07-02  
GOVERNING THE ASSIGNMENT OF CASES INVOLVING TRUSTS  
WITH DIRECTION TO THE CLERK OF COURT, ORANGE COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article V, Section 2(d) of the Florida Constitution and section 43.26, Florida Statutes, the chief judge of each judicial circuit is charged with the authority and the power to do everything necessary to promote the prompt and efficient administration of justice; and

**WHEREAS**, Administrative Order No. 2004-07-02, having fulfilled the purpose for which it was issued and is no longer required;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I**, Donald A. Myers, Jr., pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida, under Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, hereby order the following, effective **immediately**:

1. Administrative Order No. 2004-07-02 is formally vacated effective January 1, 2020. Vacating an Administrative Order that vacates a prior Order does not revive the prior Order.
2. Trust cases currently assigned among the Civil Subdivisions shall be reassigned to Subdivision 01-5, the Probate/Trust Subdivision, via separate order effective January 2, 2020.
3. Effective January 1, 2020, the Clerk of Court shall begin assigning all newly filed cases involving trusts to Subdivision 01-5.
