
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER VACATING 2018-06-01

By the power vested in the chief judge under Article V, section 2(d) of the Florida Constitution, section 43.26, Florida Statutes, and Rule 2.215 of the Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, effective **immediately**, unless otherwise provided herein, to continue until further order and superseding any provisions in prior Administrative Orders that may be inconsistent, it is **ORDERED**:

Administrative Order No. 2018-06-01, entered on January 5, 2021,
Amended Administrative Order Governing Batterers' Intervention
Program Providers, Ninth Judicial Circuit;

having fulfilled the purpose for which it was issued and is no longer required is formally vacated effective **immediately**. Vacating an Administrative Order that vacates a prior Order does not revive the prior Order. The Department of Children and Families is responsible for oversight and monitoring of Batterer Intervention Programs throughout the State of Florida.
